Authority in & about the premises, & upon Rec<sup>t</sup>:  
of any such summes of money foresaid. Acquittan-  
ces or other discharges for me & in my name to  
make & give, & for me & in my name so doe &  
performe as fully & largely in every respect to all  
intents and purposes as I my selfe might or could  
doe if I were there personally present ratifying  
confirming & allowing all & whatsoever my said  
Attorn: y shall lawfully doe or cause to be done in  
& about the premises afor: s<sup>d</sup>: by Vertue of these presents
